The Cities of Neenah and Menasha, Wisconsin, are currently accepting applications for Fire Chief of Neenah-Menasha Fire Rescue, a 68 member department with four stations that serves a population base of approximately 44,000 people. This individual needs to be a progressive, energetic leader who communicates openly and focuses on continuous improvement while serving as Fire Chief. The position manages the day-to-day operations of the department and is also responsible for fostering internal and external relationships. Person filling the position will also serve as the Emergency Management Director for the City of Neenah. The work is performed under the direction of the Mayors of both Neenah and Menasha.

Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field required. Seven years progressively responsible fire service supervisory experience (move-up Fire Officer or higher) required. Fire Officer I, Wisconsin Firefighter I and Wisconsin Firefighter II, Driver/Operator- Pumper certifications and valid driver's license required. Employees with equivalent out-of-state certifications must receive the Wisconsin certifications within 12 months of hire. Chief Fire Officer Certification and/or Executive Fire Officer (EFO) Certifications from the National Fire Academy preferred. NIMS 100, 200, 300, 400 and 700 certification required or must be completed within 12 months of hire. Experience or training in management, budgeting and strategic planning is a plus.

Applicant must have or be able to obtain a valid Wisconsin driver's license. Salary range is \$73,411.00 to \$115,094.00 with competitive benefits.
